General Description

The LC-T801 is a receptacle adapter that converts an LC receptacle into a 1.25mm ARINC 801 receptacle, utilizing features found in the COTSWORKS LC Tab (LC-T) connector and industry-standard ARINC 801 terminus retention features. The LC-T801 uses identical spring clips utilized by the COTSWORKS RCP module and is similar to those implemented in 38999 circulars, EN4165 squares, and the rectangular EPX connectors. These design features allow transceivers with LC receptacles to upgrade to a more rugged ARINC 801 style terminus.





Guidelines

Installation Guidelines

- Insert an ARINC 801 termini into the LC-T801 Receptacle Adapter Body
- Push the ARINC 801 termini forward until the ARINC retention clip is fully engaged
- Install the LC-T801 adapter into an LC receptacle

Removal Guidelines

- If installed in an LC receptacle, depress the LC-T801 retention clip and pull the adapter backward to remove it from the LC receptacle
- Insert an ARINC 801 removal tool into the back of the LC-T801 Receptacle Adapter Body
- While holding the adapter body gently, pull back on the ARINC 801 termini and removal tool
